

Graffiti – Glossary

around adverb, preposition
used for referring to a time that is not exact

authorities noun [plural]
the police or people in other official organizations with legal power to make people obey laws or rules

deal with verb [transitive]
to take action to do something, especially to solve a problem

depends on phrase
if one thing depends on another, it is changed or affected by the other thing

elsewhere adverb
in or to another place or other places

erupt verb [intransitive]
if a volcano erupts, it explodes inside and flames, rocks, and lava come out of the top

factor noun [countable]
one of the things that influence whether an event happens or the way that it happens

in place phrase
in the correct position

justifiable adjective
if something is justifiable, there is a good reason for it
Can such violence ever be justifiable?

justification noun [countable/uncountable]
a reason why something is correct and morally right
There can be no justification for such rude behaviour.

multicoloured adjective
consisting of several different colours
a multicoloured flag

passionate adjective
showing or expressing strong beliefs, interest, or enthusiasm

permission noun [uncountable]
the right to do something that is given to you by someone in authority

property noun [countable/uncountable]
land and the buildings on it
The sign said 'Private Property, Keep Out'.

remains noun [plural]
the part of something that is left after the rest has been finished, used, or destroyed
The remains of the castle can still be seen on the hill.

spray noun [countable/uncountable]
a liquid product in a container that you use by pushing a button so that the liquid is forced out through a small hole into the air
a spray bottle/can
