animation noun [countable]
an animated film or cartoon

astronaut noun [countable]
someone who travels and works in space

character noun [countable]
a person in a book, play, film etc
The film's central character is played by George Clooney.

destroy verb [transitive]
to damage something so severely that it no longer exists or can never return to its normal state

dozens determiner (plural)
lots of things or people

emotion noun [countable/uncountable]
a feeling that you experience, for example love, fear, or anger
Jealousy is an uncomfortable emotion.

ending noun [countable]
the way in which something such as a story, film, or play ends

human noun [countable]
a person

intend verb [transitive]
to have a plan in your mind to do something

present adjective
existing somewhere
The chemicals obviously kill any bacteria present.

rubbish noun [uncountable]
things that you throw away because they are no longer useful, such as old food, paper or plastic used for wrapping things, and empty containers

shape noun [countable/uncountable]
the outer form of something

studio noun [countable]
a company that produces films

success noun [uncountable]
the achievement of something that you planned to do or attempted to do

theme noun [countable]
the main subject of something such as a book, speech, art exhibition, or discussion

unhappy adjective
feeling sad or upset
Why are you so unhappy?

upset adjective
very sad, worried, or angry about something
Poor Bill looked terribly upset.

voice noun [uncountable/countable]
the sounds that someone makes when they speak
