

Toy Story 3 – Glossary

animation noun [countable]
an animated movie or cartoon

astronaut noun [countable]
someone who travels and works in space

character noun [countable]
a person in a book, play, movie, etc.
The book has a solid plot and likable characters.

destroy verb [transitive]
to damage something so severely that it no longer exists or can never return to its normal state

dozens determiner [plural]
lots of things or people

emotion noun [countable/uncountable]
a feeling that you experience, for example love, fear, or anger
Jealousy is an uncomfortable emotion.

ending noun [countable]
the way in which something such as a story, movie, or play ends

human noun [countable]
a person

intend verb [transitive]
to have a plan in your mind to do something

main adjective [only before noun]
most important, largest, or most frequently used
The movie's main character is played by George Clooney.

present adjective
existing somewhere
The chemicals obviously kill any bacteria present.

shape noun [countable/uncountable]
the outer form of something

studio noun [countable]
a company that produces movies

success noun [uncountable]
the achievement of something that you planned to do or attempted to do

theme noun [countable]
the main subject of something such as a book, speech, art exhibit, or discussion

trash noun [uncountable]
waste material such as paper, plastic bags, used containers, etc.
The average American family produces three pounds of trash a day.

unhappy adjective
feeling sad or upset
Why are you so unhappy?

upset adjective
very sad, worried, or angry about something
They felt too upset to talk about the incident.

voice noun [countable/uncountable]
the sounds someone makes when they speak
